## **Patient Comment and Suggestion Box**

- Hook on back of door in patients toilet for bags/walking stick Will arrange for hooks for patient toilets on both sites
- Triage system very off putting. That you will be rung back any time and where ever you are and that there is such a barrier between you and the doctor Noted. Have received both positive and negative comments with regard to the triage system. It is not intended to be a block between the patient and the GP. Patients can ask for a GP appointment. They do not have to disclose information to the Practice Nurse if they do not want to.
- Comment about radio not being on, confidentiality issue but then it was turned on. Suggest may be practical idea to introduce a 'cheese counter' method (numbered ticket issued on arrival) so patients have an idea of how long they may have to wait thus if have time could go for a coffee or for a brisk walk or cycle. Oversight that radio was not turned on. This is normally done every morning. Emergency clinic is 'sit and wait' and, unfortunately, there are times when this can be a considerable time.
- Can we please do without Radio 2 -Radio 2 is a suitable mix of talking and music for all ages and will not be changed. Unfortunately we cannot please everyone.
- Stickers for kids visits to the doctor Good idea, and will purchase
- Please consider using paper cups for supplying water, not plastic
   Will look into associated costs.
- When you show patients name and room number on the display device, suggest also include name of doctor as not all doctors introduce themselves Not possible to include name on display as rooms are used by various clinicians hence the room number is displayed. Reminder to doctors running emergency clinic to introduce themselves. Not an issue for routine clinics as patient would have the name of clinician they have been booked in with.
