Patient Access for appointments

The practice is open as normal and we are continuing to triage all routine and urgent GP appointment requests. The practice nurse will assess your concerns and offer you a telephone/video consultation with a GP or another healthcare professional that meets your needs. If the Doctor feels you need to be seen they will make appropriate arrangements and advise you accordingly.

We are continuing to provide childhood immunisation appointments with the practice nurse.

Women's Health checks are available by telephone consultation with the practice nurse.

The HCA/phlebotomy team are available for essential blood tests and some routine screening.

The Pharmacy team are available daily for medication queries.

We are continually reviewing our processes to ensure that we can prevent the spread of infection and protect our patients and staff.
