Nearly thirty years ago on the 4th December 1994, Hay and District Dial-a-Ride began after a small group of locals saw there was a need for community transport for the elderly and disabled. I am glad to see that we are still providing the service we started but now with lots of extra features: prescription deliveries, social trips, transport to luncheon clubs, medical appointments via community cars, as well as day trips further afield to Barry Island and Mumbles (we are hoping to do longer day trips again once our new minibus arrives). This has all been possible thanks to a local band of volunteers, some of whom have been with us for years, as well as a very efficient team in our office.

It has far exceeded the scope we originally thought was needed when started all those years ago. And my hope is that it will continue to grow and expand whilst serving the needs of local people.
